#### **POOL**

The summer is in full swing and we hope you will be able to spend much of it at the pool.

We'll be having a few pool games scheduled during the summer. They will be scheduled for Saturdays or Sundays, last an hour, and will be open to all children. Events can include pool scavenger hunts, relays, etc. We'll also have some events for the younger children who use the baby pool. Information will be posted at the pool and on the club's website www.carefreeclub.org/Pool.

The 2016 pool rules are on the Carefree Club website on the pool tab. Please take a moment to review them. Of particular note:

Lifequards are in charge at all times.

Your pool pass/tag is required for entry each time you visit the pool.

The number of children noted on the lot member's card are those age 10 years and younger. Older children are not included in this count since they will have a tag/card of their own to use. Children under age 3 or older children not completely potty trained are not permitted to use the main pool, including sitting on the sides or on the steps. The use of swim diapers may delay by minutes the results of an accident from entering the pool, but the bacteria and germs enter the pool water immediately (CDC). A fecal accident will mean closing the pool for at least several hours. The baby pool is great for younger children to use.

No glass containers are allowed on the pool decks and patios.

Thinking of renting the pool and patio for an after-hours event? Members can rent the pool and patio from 8-11 p.m. Information and the rental form can be found on the pool page of the club's website.

We have four home swim meets scheduled for this summer (Tuesdays and Thursdays), meaning the pool will close at 4 p.m. Please check the pool status on the main page of the club's website to see if there is a meet before heading down to the pool.

- Monday Thursday half day is \$53.50 or full day for \$80.00
- Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and holidays half day is \$80.00 or a full day for \$134.00
- Half day = 5 am 4 pm or 5 pm 4 am
- \*The above prices include sales tax.

The only requirements for renting the clubhouse are that you must be a Carefree Club member and that your dues are paid current. The Clubhouse Rental Agreement requires that the Clubhouse be returned to its SAME CLEAN CONDITION at the end of each rental so the next rental can also enjoy a clean Clubhouse. Also, all doors should be locked, all of the blinds closed, and prompt return of the key.
