POOL NEWS

Memorial Day Weekend, May 24 & 25 the pool will open and on September 6 the pool will close with the hog roast party.

We will once again be offering water aerobics for members and their guests: Monday/Wednesday/Friday from 10-11 a.m., Tuesday/Thursday from 6-7 p.m., and Saturdays from 10-11 a.m. The start date will be posted at the pool when it opens.

The pool will close at 4 pm on the days the Crocodile Swim Team meets. Those days are June 19 & 24 and July 10th.

In past seasons we have had a lot of problems with non-club members gaining access to the pool. As a club member you have a right to protect your investment. If you see a nonmember, or suspect a nonmember is at the pool without a member sponsor present, please let the assistant manager know. They will address the situation, or call the proper authorities.

A reminder to all - The guards are young adults that deserve your respect. If one of them reminds you of a rule, or asks you to change something you are doing, please do it. They are expected to enforce the rules and when you resist it is intimidating. If you resist, authorities will be called to deal with the situation. Our rules are for your protection, obey them and we will have a great summer.

NEW THIS YEAR

We have purchased a large number of lockers which are located outside the restrooms. Please bring your own lock and secure your personal items while visiting the pool. Do not leave valuables in your car. RULES - Bring your own lock and remove all items when you leave daily. Locks left overnight will be removed.

REMINDER ON IMPORTANT POOL RULES/CHANGES:

No child under 3 years old will be allowed in the big pool. Our Kid pool has plenty of depth for a good swimmer under 3 years old to enjoy.

No floatation devices (ie water wings) will be allowed in the deep end. If you can't swim a lap of the deep well without devices, you will not be allowed in it.

Rental Rates:

- Monday Thursday half day is \$50 or full day for \$75
- Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and holidays half day is \$75 or a full day for \$125
- Half day = 5 am 4 pm or 5 pm 4 am

The only requirements for renting the clubhouse are that you must be a Carefree Club member and that your dues are paid current. The Clubhouse Rental Agreement requires that the Clubhouse be returned to its SAME CLEAN CONDITION at the end of each rental so the next rental can also enjoy a clean Clubhouse. Also, all doors should be locked and the blinds closed.

SMOKE FREE – The <u>entire</u> Carefree Club property is smoke-free. This includes the Clubhouse, parking lot, playground, basketball courts, etc.

Carefree Crocodiles Swim Team - 2014

The Carefree Crocodiles Swim Team (CCST) is a recreational program that has been offering children ages 5-17 from the Carefree and surrounding communities an opportunity to "get their feet wet" with a splash of competitive swimming for more than 30 years. team, registration, and summer schedule. Our team members practice for 1 hour four times a week at the <u>Carefree Club</u> Pool. Practices are mornings on M, T, Th, & F. from 7:30 - 8:30 AM or 8:30 - 9:30 AM. During practices, our coaching staff provides instruction on proper stroke technique, starts, turns, and other components necessary to compete in meets. Please note that the Swim Team is NOT a "Learn To Swim" or swim lessons program. If you are interested in such a program, please visit our <u>swim lessons</u> page. While it's not a requirement for team members to know all the strokes or to have perfect technique, they must be able to swim comfortably in deep water.

The Swim Team is a member of the Community Swim Conference, and we swim against four other teams from the surrounding Indianapolis area in dual meets. At the end of the season, a conference meet is held with all five teams participating. The dual meets, usually 2.5 to 3 hours long, are scheduled in the evenings beginning the third week in June with Conference meet scheduled for the third week in July. Please respect the exclusive use of this dumpster by Carefree Club only and help keep our dues low.

SMOKE FREE – The entire Carefree Club property is smoke-free. All of Carefree Club grounds and facilities are smoke free. Residents (and their guests) are reminded that smoking is not permitted **anywhere** on the property at any time.

"For Sale by Owner" Notice: Residents who have their property for sale as **"For Sale by Owner"** need to contact our Corporate Secretary at <u>board@carefreeclub.org</u>. This is to ensure that all dues are current and no lien is on the property for unpaid dues.

Neighborhood News: REMC continues their work burying the primary electric lines in **Carefree North**. Work is expected to be completed in 2014. Some lines have already been buried. Residents will be partly responsible for the hook-up to an underground meter base.

General Info for Home Owners New to Carefree

Carefree Club, Inc. (Club) is a private not-for-profit organization. Pool membership is a part of membership in the Carefree Club. Membership, in the Club, is open to Carefree North and Carefree South residents. Not all properties in the Carefree community are members of the Club.

If you are purchasing or have purchased a home in Carefree, you can check with the original owners or the title company with whom you are closing your new home to see if your new home is a member of the Carefree Club. Any dues settlements will be taken care of during closing and will show up in your closing documents. Ask your closing agent if you are unsure. If you find that your home is not in the Carefree Club you may apply for membership.

Current Members

You must be a Carefree Club member in good standing in order to use the pool.

Annual Assessment (Dues)

No pool passes will be issued in person. You will receive your pool passes in the mail after your check clears. If you have lost the Dues notice, please download the assessment notice from the website. If you are paying your assessment late, you will not receive complimentary guest pool passes and you must wait until your check clears to receive your pool passes.

Requirements for New Membership

Carefree Club member's properties are permanently bound to the Club with the exception of a group of original owners as defined in the "Covenants and Restrictions." Membership requirements are as follows:

- 1. Property must be located within Carefree North or South community.
- 2. Property is bound to the Club with a filing at the Johnson County Recorder's Office. The Club will generate paperwork and filing for the property owner. Once a property is bound to the Club, the property is permanently bound. The property remains bound to the Club when the property is sold and the new property owners are responsible for dues.
- 3. Pay the pool assessment of \$600.00 (only once)
- 4. Pay the annual maintenance assessment. The current assessment is \$228.00 (yearly)

Thank you in advance for mailing your check promptly to insure you receive your pool passes by the date of the pool opening. With your cooperation, the Board of Directors can keep Carefree Club running smoothly for your family's enjoyment.

If you would like to donate an additional \$10.00 for maintenance/repair to the entrance signs/or lights at Carefree North and South, please include that amount with your yearly assessment (total of \$241.00).
