Pool News

The pool opens Saturday, May 25th at 11 a.m. We're looking forward to another great swim season. Please take a few minutes to read over the pool rules available at https://www.carefreeclub.org/Pool. Here is a Cliff Notes version (but really, please read the entire set of rules):

- You must have your pass or tag each time you come to the pool.
- Children old enough for a tag or card will not be counted as a child on their parent's card, so they will need to bring their tag or card to check in.
- The pool manager and lifeguards are in charge at all times.
- Children under age 3 are not allowed in the main pool. This includes sitting on the stairs or gutters. Swim diapers are not leak proof and an accident will close the pool for several hours.
- Parent/guardian must remain at the baby pool while their child is in the pool.
- Diving is only allowed in the deep end. Anyone using the diving board must be able to jump straight off and swim unassisted to the ladder.
- In case of thunder or lightning, both pool decks will be cleared immediately.
- No glass containers anywhere once you enter the main gates to the pool.
- The entire property is smoke-free, including e-cigarettes.

Water Aerobics

Once again we'll be offering water aerobics this summer. There is no cost and the classes are open to members and their guests. No experience necessary and no registration required – just show up for the days that work for you. This is a great way to get your workout done and meet some new friends. A nice group has formed over the past few summers, and we meet for dinner a few times during the off-season to keep in touch. During June and July the schedule is Monday/Wednesday/Friday from 10-11 a.m.; Tuesday/Thursday 6-7 p.m. The schedule will also be posted at the pool so you know which instructor is teaching the class. The August schedule will depend on the availability of the instructors and will be posted at the pool. Hope to see you there!
