In order to avoid having to close the pool in case of a fecal accident, please remember that children under age three are not permitted in the main pool. Older children must be completely potty-trained in order to use the main pool. Swim diapers for use in the baby pool are available at concession and there is a changing table in the women's restroom. We appreciate all the members who remember to bring their lot pass or tag every time you come to the pool.

For July, we are offering water aerobics from 10-11 a.m. on Monday/Wednesday/Friday and from 6-7 p.m. Monday through Friday. Sessions are free and open to members and their guests. The schedule is posted in the display case next to the concession stand window. We'll also offer some sessions on Saturdays from 11 a.m. to noon and this information will be on the schedule. With our lifeguards either leaving for college or being involved in high school activities, we'll still do our best to offer at least three sessions per week in August.
