With spring finally here, we're in the process of doing some renovations and improvements. The board of directors approved two projects recently:

- Gutters will be installed on the clubhouse and concession building. This will alleviate much of the flooding that happens between the concession window and the clubhouse kitchen and reduce the damage to the concrete along the perimeter of the buildings.
- The pool restrooms were last updated decades ago and in sore need of renovation. This will include having the showers rebuilt, new toilets installed, and new stalls in the women's restroom, wall coverings, and repainting the floors.

The work on both projects will be completed before the pool opens. Thank you for your support in making these improvements possible.

Clubhouse News

Check the availability of the clubhouse by calling 317-625-club (317-625-2582), or email the clubhouse at clubhouse@carefreeclub.org.

Requirements for renting the clubhouse:

- Must be a Carefree Club Inc. member and
- Dues must be paid in full

There are a few 2018 May and June dates still available and the 2018 December dates are going fast!

Many updates have been made to the clubhouse in the past few years such as new kitchen remodel and new tables.

Remember, when renting the clubhouse, the clubhouse must be:

- returned in the **SAME CLEAN CONDITION AND SET-UP** at the end of each rental to be ready for the next rental;
- all doors are to be locked at end of each rental;
- all blinds are to be closed at end of each rental;
- prompt return of key at end of each rental;
- This is a non-smoking facility including E-Cigarettes. Areas included in the smoking ban are the clubhouse inside/outside, parking lot, playground, tennis courts, basketball courts, patio, and pool area.

Pool News

The pool will open at 11 a.m. on Saturday, May 26th weather permitting. We're looking forward to another good summer. The pool rules are posted at <https://www.carefreeclub.org/Pool>. Here is the Cliff Notes version:

1. You must show your pool pass/tag each time you come to the pool.
2. The pool manager and life guards are in charge at all times.
3. The fire lane in front of the pool gates and clubhouse must be clear of vehicles the entire time the pool is opened per the White River Fire Department.
4. The entire Carefree Club property is smoke-free.
5. If thunder or lightening is observed, both pool decks will be cleared immediately and the pool will be closed for 30 minutes after the last thunder/lightening. If inclement weather occurs after 6 p.m., the pool may close for the rest of the day.
6. Diving is only allowed in the deep end.
7. Children under age three are not permitted in the main pool or allowed to sit on the stairs or gutters. A fecal accident will close the main pool for at least several hours. Swim diapers are not leak-proof and are not allowed in the main pool.
8. No flotation devices are allowed in the deep end. Anyone using the diving board must be able to swim unassisted to the ladder after jumping off the board.
9. Only frontward/forward dives, jumps and flips are allowed on the diving board.
10. When possible, a lifeguard will be stationed at the baby pool. Parents/guardians are responsible for their children and must remain at the baby pool while their children are in the pool.
11. Do not change diapers on the pool deck or on the chairs – please use the restrooms.

Water aerobics will begin Monday June 4th. Morning sessions (10-11 a.m.) will be held on Monday/Wednesday/Friday and evening sessions (6-7 p.m.) will be held on Tuesday/Thursday. Sessions are free and open to members and their guests. The schedule will also be posted by the pool concession stand window.
